51st ANNUAL PIONEER DAYS August 24th, 25th & 26th, 2017 Canyonville

Booth set-up begins Wednesday, August 23rd 2017 at 9 a.m., and must be completed by Thursday, August 24th 2017 at 2:30 p.m. prior to the start of Pioneer Days.

Booth Fees are non-refundable unless the event is cancelled.

All booths and materials must be removed from the park no later than 7:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 27th 2017 following Pioneer Days unless prior arrangements have been made with the Booth Chairperson.

Booth Open Hours are as follows: PLEASE NOTE NEW BOOTH HOURS

Thursday: Non Food 4:00 p.m. to 10 p.m.
Thursday: Food 6:30 p.m. to 10 p.m.
Friday 11:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
Saturday 11:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.

Booths must be open and manned for business during the above hours. Any exceptions must be cleared through the Booth Chairperson.

NO ANIMALS of any kind allowed in the vendor booth. Any exceptions must be cleared through the Booth Chairperson.

Booth teardown cannot start until 10:00 p.m. on Saturday, August 26th 2017; you must clean your area of any garbage, animal droppings, hay, etc.

MOVING VEHICLES ARE NOT ALLOWED INSIDE THE PARK DURING HOURS OF OPERATION LISTED ABOVE.

Due to underground electric and water lines, there can be no ground stakes over 18 inches in the ground.

Pioneer Days is a family-oriented Celebration. NO offensive products, visual materials, odor producing materials, illegal paraphernalia or anything that would interfere with the public's enjoyment of the Celebration will be allowed. All decisions made by the Pioneer Days Committee are final.

You are responsible to bring all equipment needed to operate your booth (example: tables, chairs, power cords, lighting for evening hours, etc.)

You are responsible for your own security of your booth and belongings – NO SECURITY IS PROVIDED.
